Definitions

- Flexibility facilities that are adaptable to varying needs and abilities in teaching and learning.
- Small Learning Communities organizing principle that allows the scale of the building to break down into smaller areas which changes the "felt size" of the school.
 - It addresses social, emotional, and security challenges associated with large schools and the anxiety those environments produce.

No educational model change proposed.







Definitions

- Collaboration working together with diverse thinkers to improve individual outcomes.
 - True collaboration is dependent upon interdisciplinary insight as well as focused departmental expertise. Innovation and discovery are rooted in collaboration.
- 21st Century Skills Communication, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, Creativity. These are layered into and enhance the traditional skills of reading, writing, and arithmetic.

- Develop concepts that respond to existing challenges and MSBA standards
- Narrow down options to arrive at preferred (most educationally appropriate and most cost effective) option



Renovation







- Eliminate congestion in corridors and at intersections that increase student anxiety and travel time. Create space and opportunity for students to collaborate with one another and space/opportunity for teachers to have departmental and interdepartmental collaboration. [RFQ, Ed Plan, SOI]
 - The addition/renovation and new building options reduce travel distances and congestion through the implementation of a second floor and multiple wings. This helps reduce the number of students moving through the "pinch points". It fosters collaboration through open common space, small group rooms, and teacher planning centers.





- Provide a safe and healthy learning environment that considers physical, emotional and academic safety while being focused on 21st century best practices. [RFQ, SOI, Strategic Plan, Ed Plan]
 - The addition/renovation and new building options provide flexible, responsive learning spaces that will help ensure the social/emotional well-being of each learner. It is safe, secure, accessible and adaptable to changing teaching practices including project based learning.





- Provide a facility that incorporates today's security concerns and any potential future security considerations; [RFQ, Ed Plan, SOI, Strategic Plan]
 - The addition/renovation and new building options provide facilities that incorporate all of the latest CPTED (crime prevention through environmental design) standards. In addition, they include concepts from industry experts on school safety and security that enhance the social and emotional wellness of all users. They allow for community use that is both safe and secure at all times.







- Eliminate the current inadequately sized educational spaces and accommodate anticipated student enrollment growth in accordance with 21st century learning and facility guidelines. [RFQ, Ed Plan, SOI, Strategic Plan]
 - The addition/renovation and new building options provide facilities that meet the MSBA standards for all educational spaces. They are focused on 21st century teaching and learning concepts that consider the entire school community. It responds to the whole child by allowing various methods of teaching and learning to compliment one another.






- Provide educationally appropriate and safe science labs, STE[A]M, maker and engineering/robotics spaces. Provide space for teachers to conduct common planning time throughout the day. [RFQ, Ed Plan, SOI]
 - The addition/renovation and new building options provide science labs that are situated along the main corridor and adjacent to one another in pairs with close proximity to STEAM, engineering and maker spaces as well as common teacher planning centers. The labs will be dedicated science labs following the MSBA science lab standards. The educators and administration will implement rigorous lab safety protocols.





Option R-1 (Renovation) – Floor Plan










Option R-1 (Renovation) – Site Phasing









Option AR - 1 (Addition / Renovation) - Site Plan










Option AR - 1 (Addition / Renovation) - First Floor Plan










Option AR - 1 (Addition / Renovation) - Second Floor Plan













Multi-phased addition/renovation option. Addition would be constructed and occupied prior to demolition of the old classroom wing.

Renovation of the existing kitchen, arts, music, drama, media, entry and admin would be completed after the new addition is complete.
